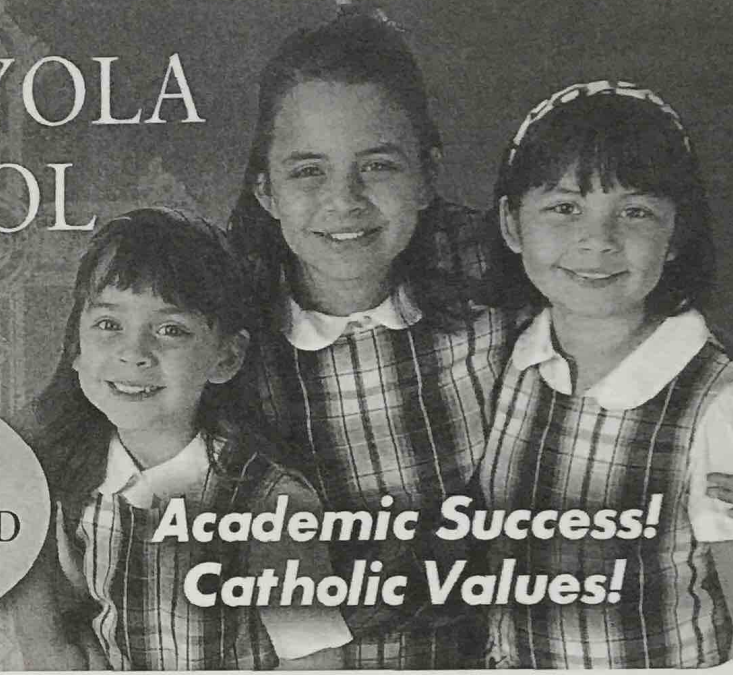

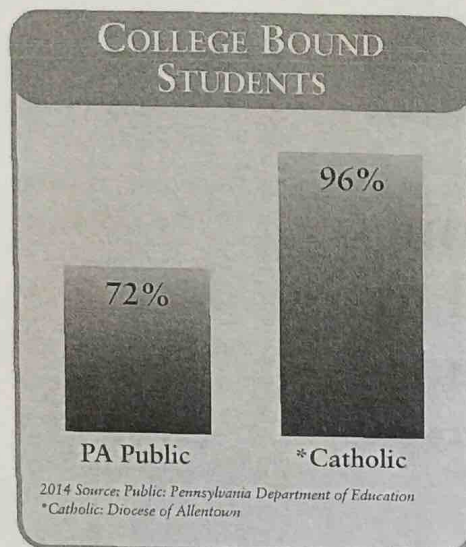

TRANSFER GRANTS UP TO \$3,000

Any public, private or charter school student who transfers into a participating Diocesan Catholic school is eligible to receive a Bishop's Tuition Transfer Grant.

Elementary students in grades 1-7, receive \$1,500 in grants (\$1,000 in year 1 and \$500 in year 2). High school transfers in grades 10 and 11 will receive \$3,000 in grants (\$2,000 in year 1 and \$1,000 in year 2). Restrictions apply. For details, contact a Catholic school.

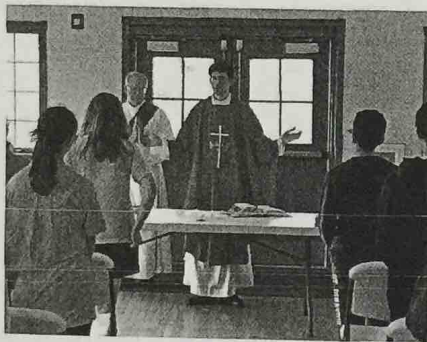
TEACHERS

PRIESTS/ RELIGIOUS

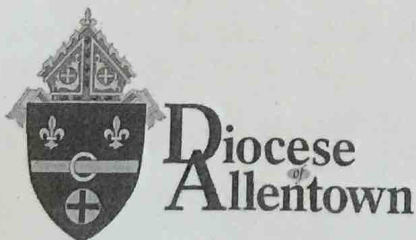
Our priests and religious are present in our schools as administrators, chaplains and teachers in our classrooms. Their dedication to the Catholic faith is passed on to our students.
